This year’s walk is dedicated to Albert “Al” Imm. Al Imm was born and raised in Turton, SD and is a graduate of Doland High School. He worked at Titan and Minuteman Missile sites near Rapid City, SD and then moved to Detroit, Michigan, where he worked for General Motors. After a few years, he moved back to Turton, SD where he had a custom spray service and was engaged in farming most of his adult life.

Al married Rita (Boik) and they had four children and nine grandchildren. He sold his land and worked as a Crop Adjuster until his health declined. In 2007, Al was diagnosed with Alzheimer’s. In 2013, Al and Rita moved to Watertown, SD and Al entered a long-term care facility for the last six years of his life until he passed away in October of 2019. His widow, Rita Imm, is a valued member of the Watertown Area Memory Care & Aging Network and is part of the Memory Care Walk Committee.

Funds raised help support local Memory Care Support Group, respite care scholarships for caregivers, the Mary Drake Resource Library, and national research for dementia-related illnesses, such as Alzheimer’s Disease.
